After thorough discussion with the Directors and investigation of associated financial processes we identified a number of areas that were obstacles to creating a more successful business.

Areas of concern we identified were:

- Labour cost overruns on projects.
- Inventory levels not accurate, leading to overstocked items.
- Despite making a healthy profit the question was always, "Where is the money"?

Outcomes of our work included:

- Introduction of a time billing system in MYOB enabling the Directors to see a daily report on the labor cost expended on each project.
- Updating information in the inventory module of MYOB.
- Created a monthly 'Snapshot Report" showing company performance, cash flow position, and cash outlays for investment in capital items.

As a result of these changes the Directors are thrilled at having crucial information available in a timely, accurate and simple format. They said:
